## **Tour I**

**Friday, February 26, 2010 from 12:00pm – 4:00pm**  
**Balboa Art Conservation Center - \$30 per person**

The Balboa Art Conservation Center was formed to aid in the preservation of works of art and other objects of cultural interest, exclusively for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes. Bradford Claybourn, our Mission Museum Curator, will lead our tour. The painting that the BACC is conserving for the Mission San Luis Rey, *The Last Judgment*, is the most significant piece of art in its collection and is currently part of the five city bi-national exhibition entitled *The Art of the Missions of Northern New Spain*. It was displayed in Mexico City, the first venue, as a work in progress. It will return to the exhibition as a completed work in time for the Oakland Museum venue. For the tour, participants will have the opportunity to visit a working lab. This tour will begin with Lunch at the Mission. We will depart from the Mission at 12:45 and return by 4:00pm.

## **Tour II**

**Sunday, February 28, 2010 from 10:00am – 4:00pm**  
**Explore the history and culture of the Pechanga, Pala and Luiseno Tribe's.**  
**\$50 per person – Includes Box Lunch**

### **Pechanga Band of Luiseno Indians Cultural Center**

The Pechanga Cultural Center stands as a testament to the Pechanga Tribe's historical resiliency and unwavering dedication to honor their heritage. The Cultural Center acts as repository for the Tribe's cultural heritage through the preservation of oral histories, archival materials and objects of cultural, historical and artistic significance to the Pechanga people.

### **Temecula Valley Museum**

Exhibits represent life in the Temecula Valley through time and different cultures that influenced the development of the area. Displays contain handcrafted artifacts, cultural items, ranching and farming equipment, documents, photographs, and more. Exhibits depict key stories, including the Luiseno Indians, Mission San Luis Rey period, establishment of the ranchos, and transportation influences including the stagecoach and railroads.

### **The Pala Band of Mission Indians – Cupa Cultural Center**

The Cupa Cultural Center was founded in 1974 through the efforts of Pala community members who were dedicated to preserving, perpetuating and enhancing traditional cultural practices.

### **Rancho Guajome Adobe**

Museum and adobe building built circa 1850 by the original Mexican land grant owners. The rancho's centerpiece was its adobe home. At nearly 7000 square feet and containing 28 rooms, it was certainly an imposing dwelling. Even its adobe bricks were impressive – each weighs between 50 and 70 pounds. Today the adobe stands as one of our best examples of Anglo-Hispanic architecture and has been designated both a State and National Historic Landmark.
